Report Cards - Important Information

Quarter 1 report cards are set to be visible to families on ParentVue after school on Friday, November 7. If you would like to receive a paper copy of your student's report card, please log into your ParentVue account and update your preference under "My Account". You will need to uncheck the box that asks if you want to go paperless. Both parents need to uncheck the box for paperless in order to receive paper report cards. Please note that mailed report cards will arrive home the week of November 10.
