Track & Field

- During competition, we ask that all spectators stay off the track and turf.
- Players, officials, and athletic event staff should be the only ones on the track and turf area
- Bleachers are available for spectators and athletes who are not competing.

Baseball (Upper grass Field)

- During competition, no spectators will be allowed on the baseball field area.
- Players, officials, and athletic event staff should be the only ones on the field area
- Limited seating is available in the bleachers of the baseball field, spectators can also bring their own chair and sit outside the fence.

Softball (Erv Lind Stadium)

- During competition, no spectators will be allowed on the softball field area.
- Players, officials, and athletic event staff should be the only ones on the field area.
- Spectators may sit in designated bleacher areas.

Gymnasium (Boys Volleyball)

• We ask all spectators to sit in the designated and labeled seating areas.

JV Softball (Clinton Park)

• For all games at Clinton Park, bleacher seating is available and grass areas outside playing area.

Mt. Tabor Park/Clinton Park (Tennis)

• Seating is not available, bring your own chair and stay clear of playing area.
