Summer Acceleration Academy 2023

We are so excited that many of our students who need additional support in grade level reading and math learning will have the opportunity to participate in Summer Acceleration Academy this summer from July 10 - August 4, 2023 from 9am - 1pm with optional afternoon programming until 5:30pm through SUN or RESJ partners. Students from Vernon will be attending SAA at the Faubion hub site.

Invitations for Summer Acceleration Academy are based mid-year assessments identifying students who would benefit from support in reaching grade level reading and math during this four week program. Families of students who are invited to participate in Summer Acceleration Academy will have received invitations to enroll online or through the school office by calling or returning a paper form that will be sent home in backpacks.

We feel this is an important opportunity for your student and understand that you may have other students in your house who need summer activities who do not meet the criteria for SAA. The RESJ department will be offering summer activities at many of the SAA sites. Stay tuned for enrollment information that will be coming soon.
