Portland Custodians' Civil Service Board Established 1937 July 5, 2023 Board Minutes Summary

The Official Minutes of the Portland Public Schools Custodian Civil Service Board are Sound Recordings of the Meetings. The following is a summary of the July 5, 2023, meeting.

A meeting of the Portland Public Schools Custodian Civil Service Board was held on July 5, 2023, via Google Meet. Mr. Frank Leavitt and Roshni Sabedra hosted the meeting remotely from their offices in the Blanchard Education Service Center, 501 N Dixon Street, Portland, Oregon. CCSB Chair Brian Caufield, Board Member Laird Cusack, and Board Secretary Jo McClain were in attendance via Google Meet. The presiding officer of the meeting was Brian Caufield. Tim Carman were also present.

The meeting was called to order at 4:03 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Approval of Proposed Minutes

The Minutes of the June 21, 2023 meeting were approved as read.

2. Approval of Hiring List

Statistics provided by Mr. Leavitt included 11 applicants, 6 who took the test, 3 who were interviewed, and 3 candidates are on the hiring list. The average test score was 100%, the average interview score was 63.4%, and the overall average was 81.7%. Mr. Caufield confirmed that the Board's Rule and Regulations were followed, and the list was approved.

3. Status of HB3227

Mr. Leavitt indicated HB3227 has passed the Senate. In response to a question from Mr. Cusack, he did not have an effective date for implementing the bill, but said he would find that out.

There was a general consensus that PPS and SEIU would need to meet to revise the rules to reflect the new hiring requirements. Mr. Curtin, for SEIU, said the parties were taking steps to make that happen.

The next meeting was set in the two-week rotation for July 19, and the current meeting adjourned at 4:06.
