A meeting of the Portland Public Schools Custodian Civil Service Board was held on May 24, 2024, via Google Meet. The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Approval of Proposed Minutes of April 23, 2024

The minutes of the April 23 minutes were approved as read.

2. Approval of Hiring List

Statistics provided by Mr. Frank Leavitt prior to the meeting included 33 applicants, 12 who took the test, 4 who were interviewed, and 4 candidates are on the hiring list. The average test score was 96.4%, the average interview score was 65.2%, and the overall average was 80.8%. Mr. Caufield confirmed that the Board's Rule and Regulations were followed, and the list was approved.

3. Relevant Updates if any

Mr. Leavitt reported that SEIU and PPS had agreed on the revision of Chapter 3 incorporating the recent legislative changes. They will be available for board review in the next 4-6 weeks.
