Board Minutes Summary

The Official Minutes of the Portland Public Schools Custodian Civil Service Board are Sound Recordings of the Meetings. The following is a summary of the July 29, 2024 meeting.

A meeting of the Portland Public Schools Custodian Civil Service Board was held on July 29, 2024 (one day earlier than originally scheduled), via Google Meet. Mr. Frank Leavitt and Ms. Roshni Sabedra hosted the meeting remotely from their offices in the Blanchard Education Service Center, 501 N Dixon Street, Portland, Oregon. CCSB Board Chair Brian Caufield, Board Member Paul Hathaway, and Board Secretary Jo McClain, were also in attendance via Google Meet.

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Approval of Proposed Minutes of July 16, 2024

Mr. Caufield moved to approve the minutes of the July 16 meeting as read, and Mr. Hathaway seconded the motion.

2. Approval of Hiring List

Mr. Leavitt for PPS reported that there had been 12 applicants, 6 who took the test, 9 who were interviewed, with 7 candidates are on the hiring list. (Some of the interviewees were from a prior testing group.) Statistics provided earlier by Mr. Leavitt indicated that the average test score was 97.6%, the average interview score was 68.4%, and the overall average was 82.65%. Mr. Caufield confirmed that the Board's Rule and Regulations were followed, and the list was approved by motion of Mr. Hathaway.

3. Relevant Updates if any

Discussion about rule revisions was tabled for the following meeting. Mr. Leavitt noted that several key people were absent during the summer.

The next meeting was set per the two week schedule for August 13. The meeting was adjourned at 4:07.
