## KBPS 2 Intro to Radio Broadcasting

Credit: .5 Grade: 10

Prerequisite: None

This course is one of four, nine-week, two period rotations for sophomores. Required for students planning to major in KBPS Radio Broadcasting.

KBPS 2 provides an introduction into radio broadcasting by offering the opportunity to obtain basic skills in the operation of industry standard broadcasting equipment in practice labs. Subject areas include: history, announcing skills (public speaking), programming, formats, news, commercials, and digital audio production.

## KBPS 3 Radio Broadcasting

Credit: 2.0 Grade: 11

Prerequisite: B in KBPS 2

This is a two-period, year-long course.

In KBPS 3, Students improve skills and knowledge in communications industries, broadcasting equipment, production and overall oral communications skills. Subject areas include: ratings and research, sales, government regulations, AP style, improving diction, announcing skills and digital audio production. On air broadcasting opportunities are available.

## KBPS 4 Senior Radio Broadcasting

Credit: 2.0 Grade: 12

Prerequisite: B in KBPS 3

This is a two-period, year-long course.

KBPS 4 students take their broadcasting skills to the next level. They delve deeper into communications knowledge, broadcasting equipment skills, production skills, written communications skills, overall oral communications skills and improve public speaking skills. Subject areas include: ratings and research, sales, government regulations, AP style, editing wire copy, improving diction, announcing skills and digital audio production.
