3.50.021-AD Supervision

- (1) <u>Teams</u>. All teams, or parts thereof, practicing for or competing in the interscholastic program of the district shall at all times be under the direct supervision of the coach. Other designated members of the faculty may be assigned to assist in that supervision as assistants to the coach or may, from time to time as may be decided by the head coach with the approval of the principal, be delegated primary responsibility for such supervision.
 - (a) <u>Student teachers or other volunteers</u> may not be given direct and primary responsibility for supervision of team activities.
 - (b) <u>Coaches</u> are responsible for controlling vulgar and profane language and violent or other extreme behavior that might be directed by team members toward players, umpires or spectators.

(2) Contests - Student Conduct.

- (a) The principal or his/her authorized representatives shall be responsible for all teams and other school groups participating in home or away-from-home contests. He/She or his/her appointee shall be ultimately responsible for all matters affecting the team, school group or the school.
- (b) The school must be considered responsible for all acts of the participating team or school group. Banners or signs which may inflame an opposing student body or which are otherwise unsportsmanlike shall not be displayed in gymnasiums or on athletic fields immediately before or during athletic contests.
- (c) Any school whose students, supporters, rooters, or partisans take part in riots, fights, pilfering or any unsportsmanlike conduct shall be subject to fine and/or suspension by the OSAA.

(3) Supervision of School Related Events.

- (a) <u>Football (Varsity Only)</u>: An administrator from each school shall be present.
- (b) <u>Volleyball, Soccer, Cross Country (Varsity Only):</u> The home school or home team will be responsible for an administrator or licensed designee. The designee is not to be the coach.
- (c) <u>Basketball Boys (Varsity Only):</u> The home school or home team will be responsible for an administrator (could be administrative assistant) to be present. Home team administrator may request that an administrator from the visiting school be present.

- (d) <u>Baseball, Track, Golf, Tennis, Softball & Swimming</u>: The home school or home team will be responsible for an administrator or licensed designee (could be coach) to be present. Home team administrator may request that an administrator from the visiting team be present.
- (e) <u>Wrestling and Girls Basketball (Varsity Only)</u>: The home school or home team will be responsible for an administrator or licensed designee. The designee is not to be the coach. Home team administrator may request that an administrator from the visiting team be present.
