


BUILD A NEW SCHOOL & DEMOLISH THE 1909 BUILDING.

No Swing Site!

Students will remain on site in existing buildings for the duration of construction.

New Fields Timeline

Completion of new track, football field and tennis courts by Fall 2029.

Opportunity for Baseball & Softball fields to be completed sooner

Fields Temporarily Unavailable

Existing track, football field and tennis courts will be unavailable during construction. Use off site facilities for these functions.

Demolish 1909 Building

All existing buildings will ultimately be demolished, including the 1909 building, to accomodate a new building and new fields.

New Building Timeline

New building to be complete for the Fall 2028 school year.

Today's 4th graders will be the first freshman class in the new building


Implementation of Cultural Placemaking in new school and throughout the campus to honor the rich history of Jefferson HS.
