




Lincoln Rebuild Spring 2022 Update



Project Update Summer 2022

Phase 1 of the Lincoln High School rebuild project is near completion. This summer final touches will be added, including new furniture installation and the move of curriculum materials over from the old school. In the Fall of 2022 the new multi-story school building will open on the west side of the existing campus for the 2022-2023 school year. There is a plaza adjacent to the student commons for outdoor activities and gatherings. The plaza connects the campus to the neighborhood through a pedestrian-friendly design that features student bicycle parking and water efficient landscaping. Phase 2 work, which includes demolition of the old school, is set to get underway this summer.

New Lincoln Highlights

Commons and Plaza

The commons and outdoor plaza welcome students to the main entrance to Lincoln. These connected spaces serve as the heart of the school and campus.

Enhanced Arts Facilities

Specialized classrooms for 2D and 3D fine arts including photography, film, painting, and ceramics.

STEM/Maker Space and Science Labs

STEM labs and a Makerspace with tools and equipment will support project-based learning and enhance career technical programs. New science labs will support inquiry-based classes in IB Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Environmental Systems.

Career Technical Education CTE

Students can access specialized programs and labs for computer science, product design, mass communications, culinary arts, and business management programs

Performing Arts

The new performing arts facilities include a 500-seat theater, dedicated band and choir spaces, and a black box teaching theater.

Athletic Facilities

A new 1,700 seat main three court gym, weight room and wrestling/dance room. A new track and field that includes a 1,500-seat grandstand will open in 2023.




Phase 2 Work Begins This Summer

The second phase of the Lincoln rebuild includes the demolition of the 1950's building to make way for a new track and field, staff parking area, teen parent center and field storage building. Phase 2 will finish during the summer of 2023 and is scheduled to open for the 2023-2024 school year.

Construction Impacts

Construction activities will be separated by fencing providing a safe environment for students and staff. During this phase access to the school will be limited. The 14th and 16th street entrances will be closed. Please refer to the map below for more information.



Lincoln Goes Green

The new campus includes a number of green features to reduce the school's impact on the environment. The project is LEED Gold certified and includes a green roof to reduce solar heat gain and a photovoltaic solar array that will generate almost 300KW of power. The building makes extensive use of natural lighting and utilizes radiant floor heating in the main commons for high efficiency heating. The building also reused 455 solid oak planks into the wall cladding on the ground floor.
