
# **Welcome to Bridlemile Elementary**

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

# **Playful Learning is Powerful**

# Play is not a break from learning. Play is learning.

## We know children love to play. We know children learn best through play.

- Play provides opportunities for **self-discovery**, **social connections**, and discovering **new ideas**.
- Allows kinders to **try out ideas** and **use what they are learning** in their academic subjects in an open discovery environment.
- Develops imagination, speaking, listening skills and higher level thinking.
- Solidifies math and science concepts.
- Play is a time when **mistakes can be deeply explored**, while involved in dramatic play, building, and other forms of play.
- This form of learning is a **powerful tool for kinders**.


