

<u>60 Day Commencement Disqualification 2025</u>

School Board Policies:

<u>"SENIOR SKIP DAYS" (DIRECTIVE 3.20.016):</u> In addition to interrupting instruction, SSDs are a source of concern due to the heightened risk of accidents among participants during these events.

Portland schools shall grant no approval for such events. Students participating in "skip days" should be considered truant and disciplined in accordance with the usual regulations and procedures for student truancy.

<u>COMMENCEMENT DISQUALIFICATION (DIRECTIVE 4.30.022)</u>: Requiring that seniors be disqualified from participation in commencement exercises and related activities if with 60 consecutive calendar days of the last senior school day they are found to be in violation of District Alcohol or Drug policy or any violation resulting in three or more days of suspension or more serious disciplinary action.

<u>COMMENCEMENT APPAREL EXPECTATION</u>: All students must wear caps and gowns. Because this is a formal occasion, students should wear appropriate attire under their gown. **APPROVED decorations are allowed on caps.**

<u>PROM ATTENDANCE POLICY:</u> Seniors are required to maintain at least 85% attendance in order to attend prom. To support students in meeting this goal, we will offer one-on-one meetings with our attendance coach for additional assistance. Students also have access to track their attendance, with data regularly updated to ensure eligibility for participation. More details will be provided during the seniors MANDATORY meeting on April 3rd.

<u>PROM GUEST POLICY:</u> Any visitor 18 to 20 years of age, not attending high school, must meet with a Franklin High School administrator to obtain an additional district clearance form. That form and a copy of the guest's Oregon Identification Card will be required for consideration to attend the Prom.

Franklin High School's Dance Permission Form for Non-Franklin Students must be taken to your guest's school in order to obtain those necessary signatures. **This form (FHS)**Clearance Form must be returned to the Vice Principal's office M-132 by <u>Tuesday, May 13th 2025</u> (4 days prior to Prom Date) NO EXCEPTIONS!
