- **Dental Sealants:**

The program offers dental sealants at **37 Portland Public Schools (PPS)** for students in **grades 2nd, 3rd, 6th, 7th, and 8th**. It includes **oral health education** and promotes **oral hygiene** among students. A **dental hygienist** provides screenings and applies sealants to prevent cavities.

- **Referral Services:**

Referral services are available to any student in any grade who has **urgent dental needs** (e.g., tooth pain or infection), whether or not they have insurance. To make a referral, please contact the **Multnomah County School and Community Oral Health Program** at **(503) 988-3905**. A representative will assist you in scheduling an appointment for the student with their own provider or at one of Multnomah County's dental clinics.

The Tooth Taxi ([link](#))

The **Tooth Taxi** is a **38-foot mobile dental clinic** that brings dental care directly to children by visiting schools and other community sites. The dental staff assesses each child's oral health and provides comprehensive care, including **exams, x-rays, sealants, cleanings, fillings**, and **minor oral surgery**—all free of charge.

- **Oral Health Education:**

The Tooth Taxi also provides **oral health education** through classroom presentations, teaching kids how to prevent tooth decay and how a healthy mouth can affect overall health.
