
To that end, we have more exciting Earth Day news: PPS has approved plans for a new pollinator-friendly garden at Glencoe!

The new garden will:

- Support native wildlife, including birds and butterflies
- Create a vibrant and welcoming public space
- Help the school adapt to climate change
- Reduce long-term maintenance needs (including volunteer workload!)

Most of Glencoe's original landscaping dates back to the 1950s. This project will focus on the south-facing garden beds along Belmont Street, replacing old and diseased plants with native and water-wise species. Special thanks to parent volunteer Susie DesSommes for her expertise drafting a beautiful design. You can check it out below!

Glencoe PTA will lead this project beginning in phases this spring. The first plants are already in the ground!
